Thank you for your email of 30 April 2010 regarding safety issues at the south end of Cammo Walk.

In order to address the safety issues you have highlighted in your email the signs and marking squads are scheduled this week to install a "Other danger ahead" warning sign accompanied with a "Walkers in road" plate with a slow marking adjacent on the carriageway 60 metres in advance of the first bend, also the slow marking markings are to be repeated at the mid point between the two bends and also at the approach to the blind summit as shown on attached drawing.

Hopefully these measures will encourage the occasional driver who is currently approaching at an inappropriate speed to slow down. Once I have been advised by the contractor that the works have been completed I will carry out a site survey approximately 1 month later to check if these measures are having the desired effect. Thank you for bringing this road safety issue to my attention.
