Jessie's Plan

Leaving evening of Thurs 30 July, returning evening Sun 8 Aug to arrive England on Mon 9, so possibly Tues a.m. in Edinburgh.

European Bike Express will bring their "feeder" bus up to Edinburgh for supplement of £40 each return with 12 people. If 15 people, the supplement is reduced to £35 each, and if 20, the supplement is £30 each. The return cost from Middlesbrough for CTC members is £189.

Registration for the SF is separate, and costs 26 euros per person [plus possibly bank transfer charges] If you want to go, and want to stay in accommodation other than campsite (tent or campervan), it is essential to book it as quickly as possible, as there will be high demand for it. 2 of the campsites are already fully booked.

There are 2 ways to find accomm.

1. There is a list of accommodation on the website [www.sf2010-verdun.org] which you can contact and book directly.
2. .Once you have registered, SF staff will find accomm according to the option you chose on your registration. Options for accommodation are: stay with a family, stay in dormitory (usually NO cooking facilities), own tent, own campervan.
